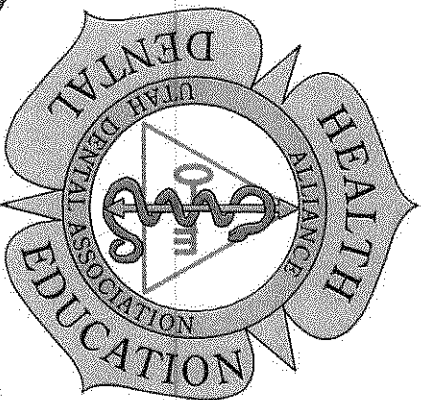


Mission Statement

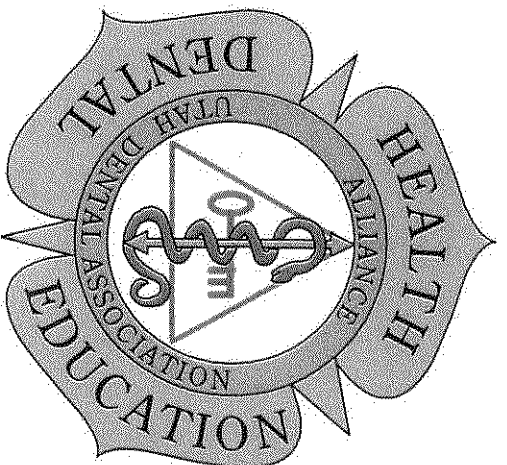
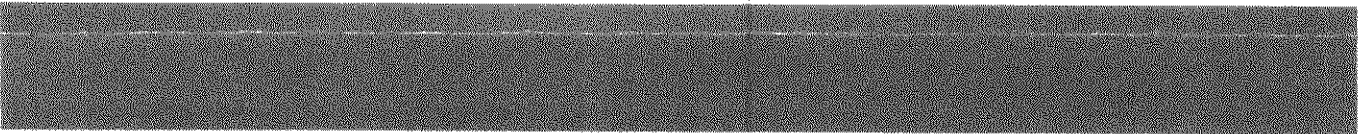
How Do I Join?
